

Strathclyde Distillery Scrubber Project

JBD Tritec were contracted to carry out the full mechanical installation of a new scrubber system at Chivas Brothers Ltd's Strathclyde Distillery in Glasgow, scrubbing exhaust gases from the dark grains plant prior to the exhaust going through the chimney stack.

Chivas Brothers is the Scotch whisky and premium gin business of Pernod Ricard – the world's co-leader in wine and spirits. Its portfolio includes Chivas Regal, Ballantine's, The Glenlivet and, Royal Salute.

Osprey were happy to engage JBD Tritec for this project as supply of tanks, pumps, valves, pipework, ducting, insulation and lift and shift works all under one contract, thus reducing

logistical problems for the client when coordinating the various trade.

The pumps were supplied through the pump division, the fabricated pipework and 1.1m diameter ducting was manufactured at the factory by our pipework and fabrication divisions. This and all the relevant equipment was installed through the roof of the building over a six week shutdown.
